

PROCEEDINGS OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF LEONVILLE, LOUISIANA, TAKEN AT A REGULAR MEETING HELD ON TUESDAY, AUGUST 12, 2025, AT 6:00 PM IN THE MEETING ROOM OF THE MUNICIPAL BUILDING.

The regular meeting of the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Leonville was held on Tuesday, August 12, 2025, at 6:00 PM in the meeting room of the Municipal Building.

The mayor called the meeting to order.

Present were Mayor Nicholas Degueyter, Council Members Kirk Stelly, Billy Lanclos, Kerry Willingham, and Amanda Herpin. Absent was Benita Kennerson.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

It was moved by Kerry Willingham, seconded by Kirk Stelly, and carried that the reading of the minutes of the previous meeting be dispensed with and accepted as written.

Chief Joseph Noel addressed council. He received funding from Act 461 of 2025 and will be purchasing surveillance equipment for main intersections. Council in agreement.

Greg Hollier, ATM provider for 4th of July fireworks was unable to attend but thanked the council.

Paul Wyble turned in an invoice for surveying of his property from 02/21/2024, stating the town is responsible. Mayor will investigate.

The council presented information from Worknet Staffing Service to receive opinion on use for staffing maintenance department. Council was in favor.

Woody Guidroz, 228 Stelly Street, has made no progress on cleaning property since last meeting, and has not sent weekly update. Contacting parish to help maintenance department clean property.

Sellers & Associates Engineering Report, Pre-construction meeting held August 5th for Street Project. Start date should be by September 15th. Wastewater Treatment Project contracts have been recorded, scheduling pre-construction meeting.

Water Sector Commission met last week, and recommended funding additional projects. Water Distribution System Improvements was on recommendation list. Town will be notified of the award. Once grant conditions are met, we will receive authorization to advertise for bids.

Motion by Amanda Herpin, seconded by Kirk Stelly and all in favor to authorize Sellers & Associates to advertise for bids for the Water Distribution System Improvement Project once approval received from OCD.

Blake Davis, supervisor, gave report. Abandoned well work is being completed. Sewer lift station at 116 St. Jules went out due to heavy use of wipes. New pump had to be purchased. Mayor stated to make sure on weekends this sewer lift station is checked thoroughly.

There being no further business, motion by Kerry Willingham, seconded by Amanda Herpin, all in favor, meeting was declared adjourned at 7:00 p.m.
