

PROCEEDINGS OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF LEONVILLE, LOUISIANA, TAKEN AT A REGULAR MEETING HELD ON TUESDAY, JANUARY 14, 2025, AT 6:00 PM IN THE MEETING ROOM OF THE MUNICIPAL BUILDING.

The regular meeting of the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Leonville was held on Tuesday, January 14, 2025, at 6:00 PM in the meeting room of the Municipal Building.

The mayor called the meeting to order.

Present were Mayor Nicholas Degueyter, Council Members Billy Lanclos, Kirk Stelly, Kerry Willingham, Benita Kennerson, Amanda Herpin.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

It was moved by Kerry Willingham, seconded by Kirk Stelly, and carried that the reading of the minutes of the previous meeting be dispensed with and accepted as written.

Dave Lemelle addressed council about drainage around 263 Lemelle St. Parish will need to dig ditches on the parish side, town will look at town side.

Frank Tujague, auditor, informed council that annual audit was sent to LLA and Bond Commission.

The mayor presented Ordinance No. 1 of 2025, Ordinance Prohibiting Businesses Selling Alcohol for Consumption on Premises and Restricting Hours of Operations for Businesses. Attorney Will Ryan was available for any questions.

It was moved by Kirk Stelly, seconded by Amanda Herpin and carried that Ordinance No. 1 of 2025, Ordinance Prohibiting Businesses Selling Alcohol for Consumption on Premises and Restricting Hours of Operations for Businesses be accepted for review and public hearing.

Chief Joseph Noel presented quotes to repair 2018 Chevrolet Tahoe, council will go with Aymonds Auto repair quote for \$5,991.63.

Woody Guidroz, 228 Stelly Street has trash in the road, town will look at cost to clean property, attorney Will Ryan will review procedure for placing a lien on the property.

Lance Lee, town manager, gave report.

Blake Davis, Supervisor, informed council that sewer system is having problems with wipes damaging sewer pumps in one area of the system, will issue letters to that area stating wipes cannot be flushed.

Stephanie Briggs gave engineering report, Water Sector response by end of January, should bid Sewer Plant Project and Street Project in February.

Annual Garage Sale will be Saturday, March 29<sup>th</sup>.
