The regular meeting of the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Leonville was held on Tuesday, May 12, 2026, at 6:00 PM in the meeting room of the Municipal Building.

The mayor called the meeting to order.

Present were Mayor Nicholas Degueyter, Council Members Kirk Stelly, Kerry Willingham, Amanda Herpin, and Billy Lanclos. Absent was Benita Kennerson.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

It was moved by Kerry Willingham, seconded by Amanda Herpin, and carried that the reading of the minutes of the previous meeting be dispensed with and accepted as written.

Kenneth Pitre spoke to mayor, town will work to clear drainage on Hurvey St.

Motion made by Kirk Stelly, seconded by Kerry Willingham and approved to sign CEA with La Dept of Veterans Affairs for FY 26-27.

The mayor presented the amended budget for FYE June 30, 2026, and the proposed budget for FYE June 30, 2027.

It was moved by Amanda Herpin, seconded by Kirk Stelly and carried that the amended budget for FYE June 30, 2026, be accepted for review and public hearing.

Lance Lee, town manager, gave report. Cellular read meters are ordered; there is training on May 18. Mayor encouraged council to attend.

Lynn Moreau updated on success of sausage poboy sale.

Jacob Moreau, Fire District 5 update. Architects are hired and process is started for new fire station. Fire hydrant testing this year for fire district rating.

Nick Degueyter, Mayor announced that through LRWA, Lance Lee is nominated for 2026 Water System Operations Specialist of the Year South Award and Christine Tidwell is nominated for 2026 Office Person of the Year South Award.


